A BILL

To amend title 28, United States Code, to establish the
National Fraud Enforcement Division of the Department
of Justice.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “National Fraud En-
5 forcement Division Act of 2026”.

6 **SEC. 2. NATIONAL FRAUD ENFORCEMENT DIVISION OF THE**
7 **DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 31 of title 28, United
9 States Code, is amended by inserting after section 509B
10 the following:

1 **“§ 509C. National Fraud Enforcement Division**

2 “(a) IN GENERAL.—There is a National Fraud En-
3 forcement Division of the Department of Justice.

4 “(b) ASSISTANT ATTORNEY GENERAL.—

5 “(1) IN GENERAL.—Of the Assistant Attorneys
6 General appointed under section 506, one shall
7 serve, upon the designation of the President, by and
8 with the advice and consent of the Senate, as the
9 Assistant Attorney General for National Fraud En-
10 forcement.

11 “(2) DUTIES.—The Assistant Attorney General
12 for National Fraud Enforcement shall—

13 “(A) serve as head of the National Fraud
14 Enforcement Division; and

15 “(B) perform such other duties as the At-
16 torney General may prescribe.”.

17 (b) PROHIBITION ON POLITICAL ACTIVITY.—Section
18 7323(b)(3) of title 5, United States Code, is amended by
19 inserting “, National Fraud Enforcement Division,” after
20 “Criminal Division”.

21 (c) TECHNICAL AND CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—
22 The table of sections for chapter 31 of title 28, United
23 States Code, is amended by inserting after the item relat-
24 ing to section 509B the following:

“509C. National Fraud Enforcement Division.”.
